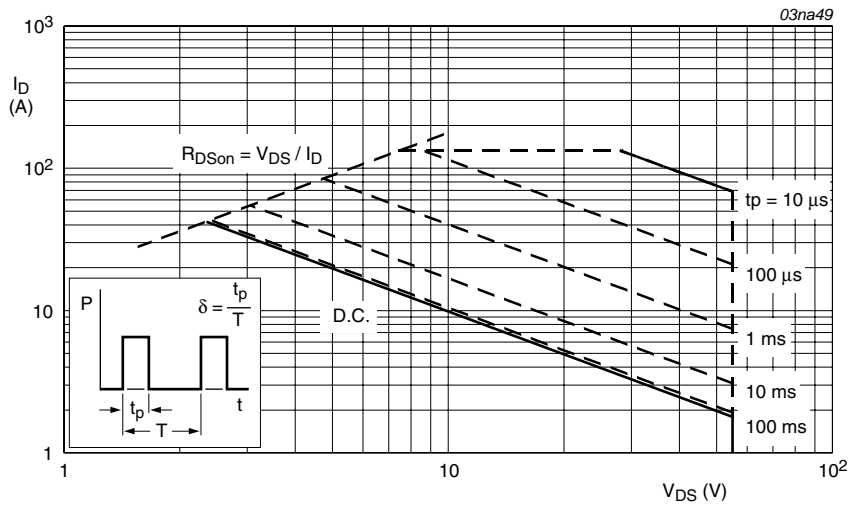

**Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature**



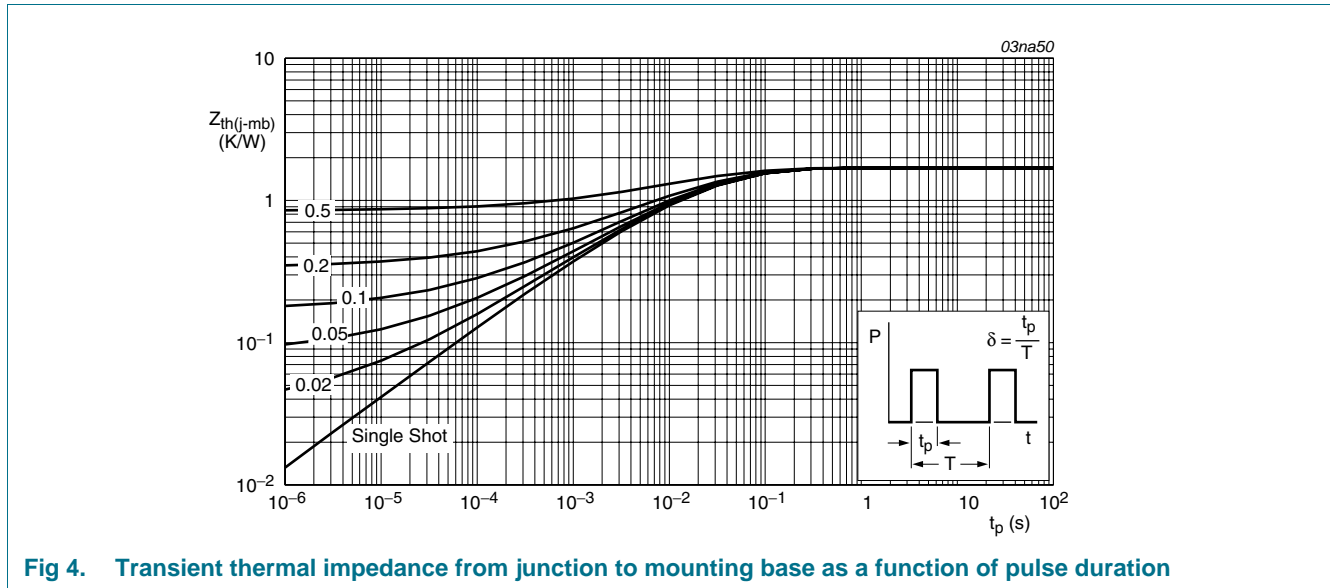

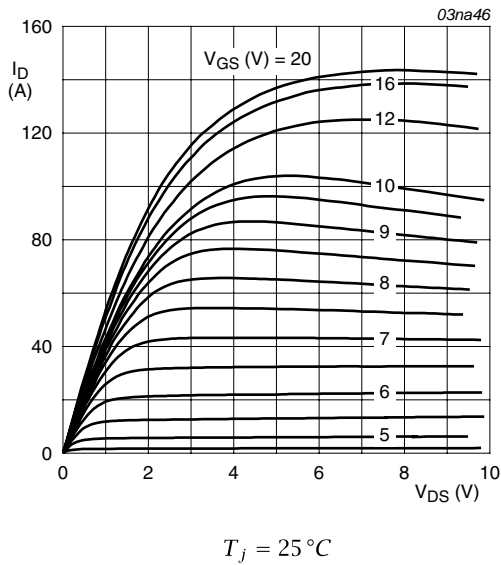


**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration**

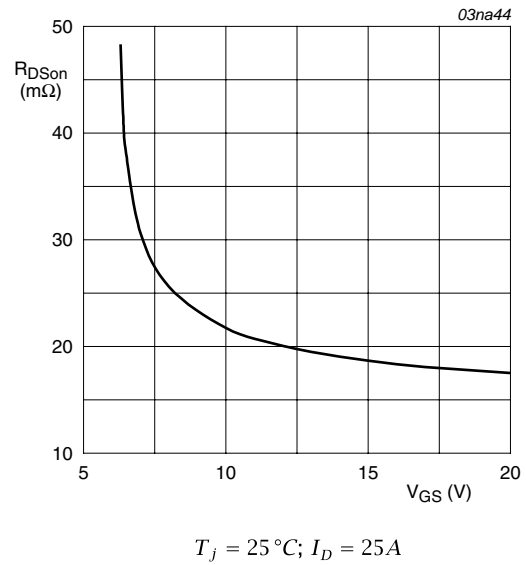

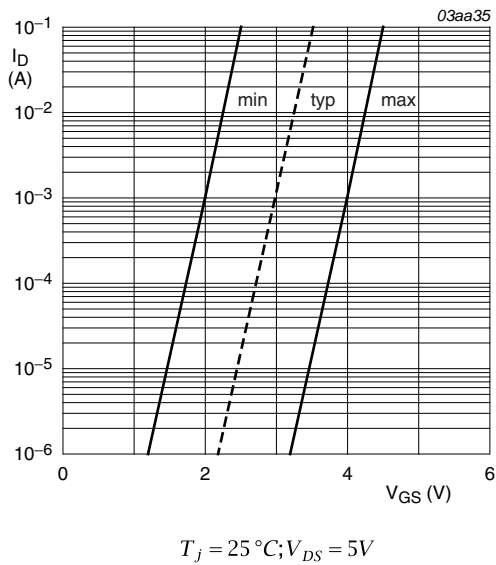

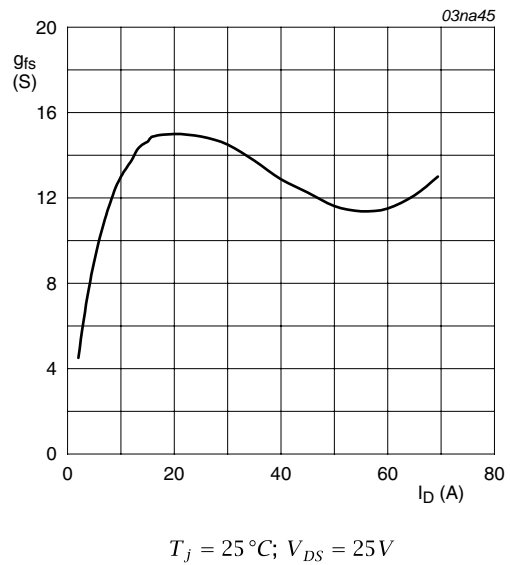
**Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**



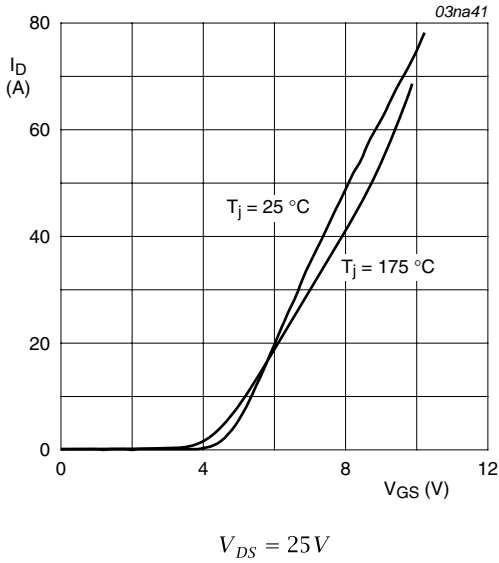
**Fig 6. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



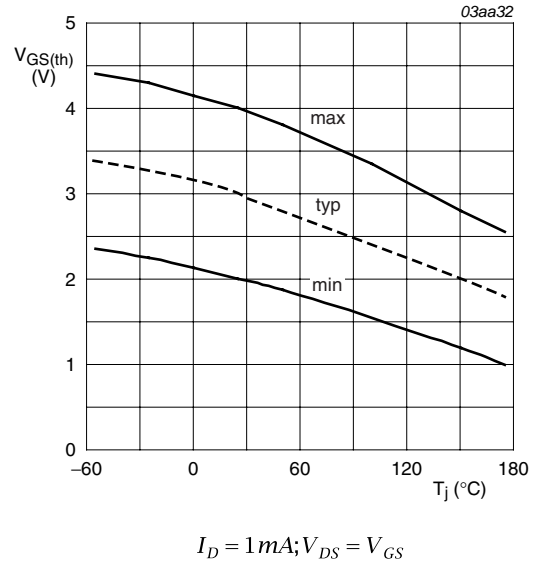
**Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**



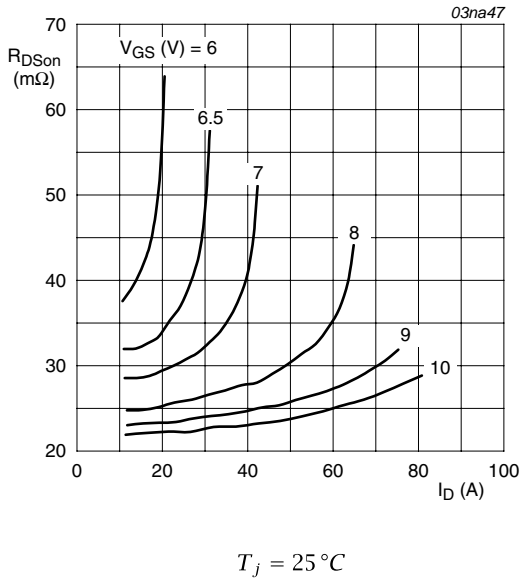
**Fig 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values**



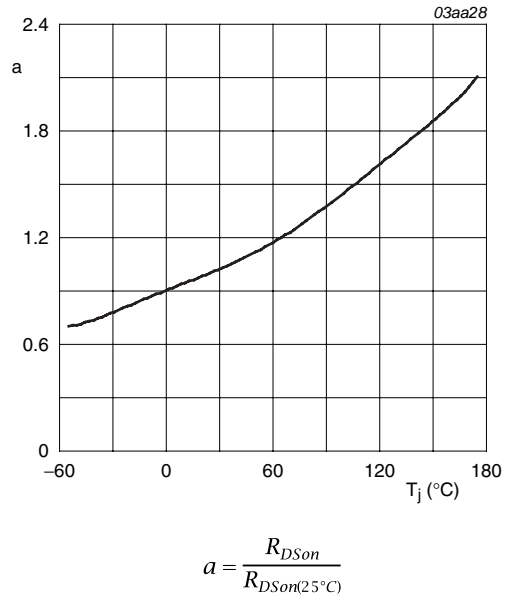
**Fig 9. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



**Fig 10. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**

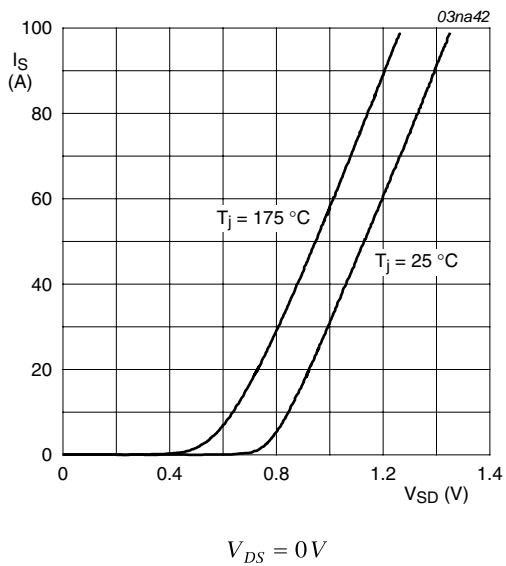


**Fig 11. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values**

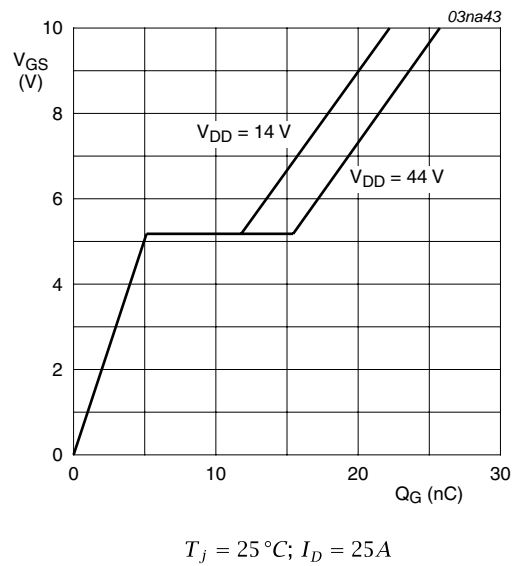


**Fig 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature**

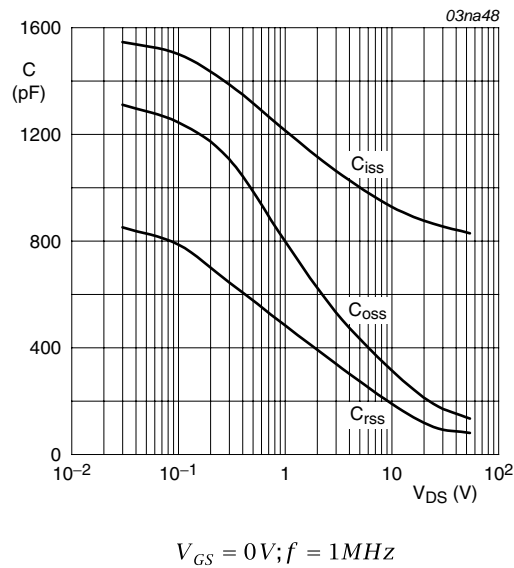




**Fig 13. Reverse diode current; typical values**



**Fig 14. Turn-on gate charge characteristics; typical values**

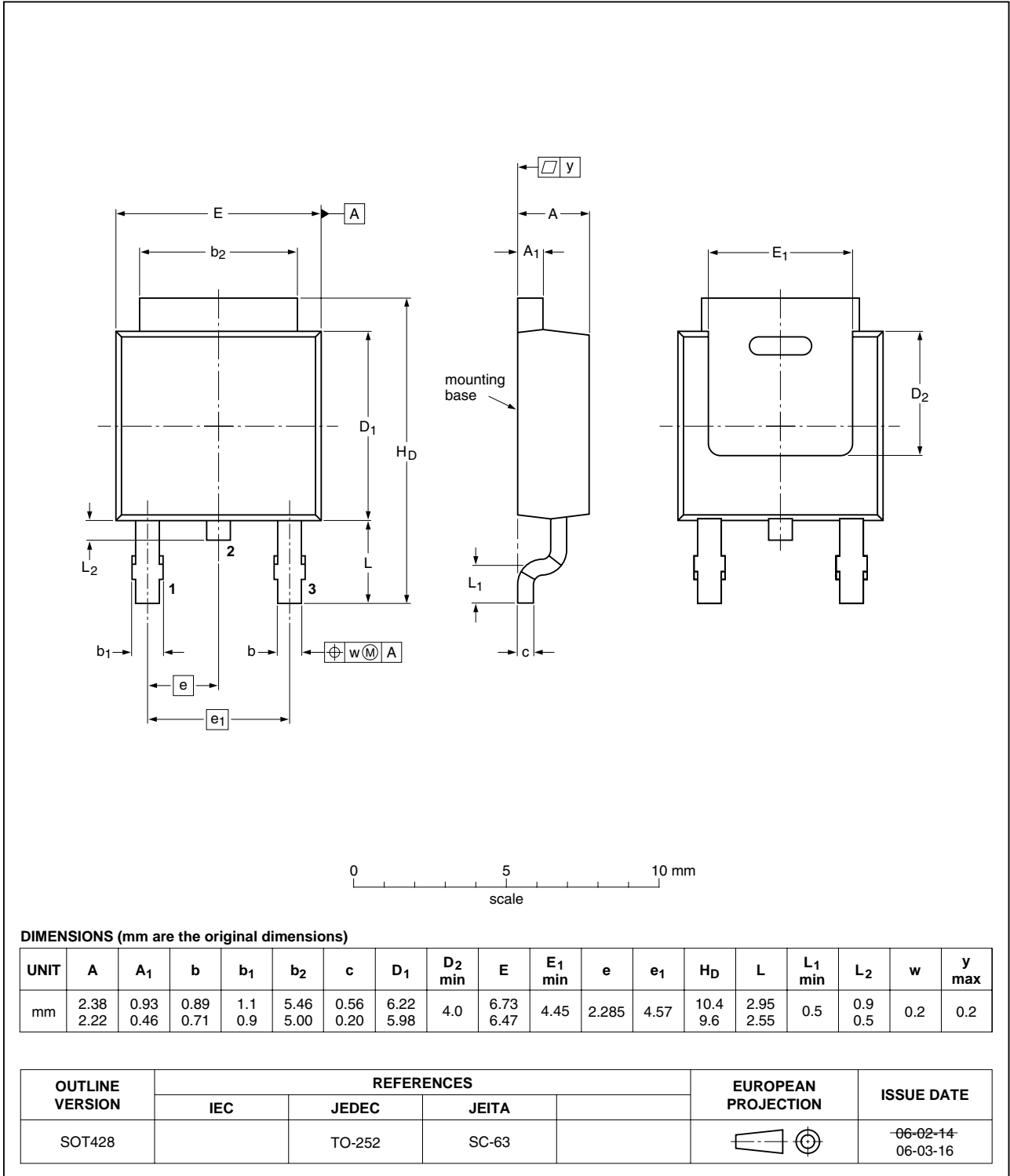


**Fig 15. Input and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**
